Dog licences are due on January 31st of each year. There is a \$15 fee for spayed or neutered (unable to reproduce) and \$25 for animals that are unaltered.

Tax Installment Payment Plan - TIPP

The Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) allows residents to sign up for a monthly, direct withdrawal of their property tax payments from their bank accounts.

This plan provides taxpayers the opportunity to pay their property taxes in monthly installments rather than the one large single payment that comes due once per year. The plan runs from January 1 - December 31, yearly. For the 2021 taxation year, your application must be received no later than February 15, 2021, provided that a pro-rated portion of your taxes are paid in advance.

Emergency Alert Program

The Town of Lamont is part of the Lamont County Regional Alert System. Get alerted about emergencies and other important community news by signing up for the Emergency Alert Program. This system enables us to provide you with critical information quickly in a variety of situations, such as unexpected road closures, water breaks and evacuations of buildings or neighborhoods. You will receive time-sensitive messages wherever you specify, such as your home, mobile or business phones, email address, text messages and more. Sidewalk Safety

For the safety of pedestrians, we ask that sidewalks are cleared of snow and ice within 24hrs of a snowfall or rainfall that creates slippery conditions. Friendly reminders will be used this year to encourage voluntary compliance. However, if a sidewalk continues to be a hazard, further enforcement measures may be taken as per the Community Standards Bylaw 07/18.

Snow Angels Program

FCSS Lamont County Region is looking for volunteers this winter who are willing to help people within the community who are unable to get outside and clear their own sidewalks and driveways of snow. We need volunteers in Lamont, Andrew, Bruderheim, Chipman and Mundare. Volunteers can be adults and school age children or it can even be a family. The volunteer is committed to the same resident throughout the Winter season but may assist more than one person, if desired. This program is for residents who have a condition or disability preventing them from participating in snow clearing activities and who have no other capable members residing in their home to assist. All residents on the program will fill out an application form and all volunteers must complete an application form and a criminal record check with the local RCMP detachment prior to being put on the list. This service is free and offered in all communities across the County provided we have volunteers.
