### **Candidates Nomination Period:**

- Candidates may submit their completed nomination papers starting January 1, 2021 up until 12:00 noon on September 20, 2021. The nomination papers must be accompanied with a deposit of \$100.00 payable by way of certified cheque, money order or cash.
- Completed Nomination Papers may be delivered in-person to the Town Office 5307-50 Avenue, Lamont, or mailed to Box 330, Lamont, Alberta TOB 2R0.
- To submit your Nomination Papers in-person, please contact 780-895-2010 to schedule an appointment.
