A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF LAMONT IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BY-LAW NO. 09/16

SUMP PUMP BYLAW

Whereas, pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, S.A. 2000, C. M-26.1, a Council may pass Bylaws respecting services provided by or on behalf of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient and proper to protect the sanitary sewer system, together with all the related appurtenances including lift stations and sewage lagoons of the Town of Lamont, by preventing the introduction of storm water or subsurface drainage to the sewer system;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Lamont properly assembled enacts as follows:

1. This By-law is known as the "Sump Pump Bylaw".

PROVISIONS

- 1. Every building in the Town of Lamont containing a basement shall employ a sump pump system.
- 2. No person shall allow water collected from foundation drains or weeping tiles, sumps from weeping tiles, roof drains, eaves troughs, yard drains or roof spouts to enter the sanitary sewer system of the Town of Lamont.
- 3. Water collected from foundation drains or weeping tiles, sumps from weeping tiles, roof drains, eaves troughs, yard drains or roof spouts shall be allowed to be connected to the storm sewer system only, wherever storm sewer systems exist.
- 4. All building downspouts and sump pump discharges shall have a drainage extension securely fastened or placed to direct drainage from a roof run-off collection system or foundation drain toward a street.
- 5. The building downspouts and sump pump discharges shall be installed in such a manner as to not cause excessive ponding or icing on public or private property.
- 6. That employees or officers of the Town of Lamont may enter onto any premises for inspection, examination and alteration of a foundation drain or weeping tile, sump from a weeping tile, roof drain, eaves trough, yard drain or roof spout connection.
- 7. Any person who has foundation drains or weeping tiles, sumps from weeping tiles, roof drains, eaves troughs, yard drains or roof spouts connected to the sanitary sewer system will be requested to remove the connection within thirty (30) days.
- 8. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and is liable for the cost of the disconnection, which shall be carried out by employees of the Town of Lamont or other person authorized by the Chief Administrative Officer to carry out the disconnection.

REPEAL

Bylaw 666/00 is hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Bylaw will come into effect upon third and final reading by Council.
