COVID-19 Update

July 1, 2021

Now that 70% of Albertans 12+ having received at least one dose of the COVID vaccination the Province moves into Stage 3 of reopening. The following changes have been made to restrictions:

- All restrictions lifted, including ban on indoor social gatherings.
- Isolation requirements for confirmed cases of COVID-19 and some protective measures in continuing care settings remain.
- The general indoor provincial mask mandate will be lifted, but masking is still required while working or visiting some health care settings, such as long term care, and while using public transit, including ride share vehicles, taxis, motor coaches and shuttles.
- Previous requirements in the existing public health orders for licensed supportive living, long-term care and hospice settings have not changed.

Plexiglass barriers, enhanced cleaning and hand sanitizing stations will remain in place at Town buildings as we adjust to Stage 3. While masks and physical distancing will no longer be mandatory the Town of Lamont is recommending the public continue to practice social distancing and wearing masks when unable to distance.

Frequently washing or disinfecting your hands, getting vaccinated and staying home when you're sick will continue to be important to protect our community and limit the spread of COVID-19.
