COVID-19 Update

February 9, 2022

As of February 9, 2022 the following changes have been made to the COVID-19 restrictions:

- Restrictions Exemption Program has been removed, along with most associated restrictions.
- Capacity limits in large facilities and entertainment venues (500+) remain in place, but food and beverages now allowed in seats.
- Capacity limits for locations not covered under the REP program are removed.
- Mandatory masking requirements removed for children 12 and under in all settings as of February 14.
- Mandatory masking requirements removed for children and youth in schools for any age as of February 14.

The Town Administration Building is now open. Masks must be worn by any one over the age of 12 who enters the building. Social distancing is required.

All Town departments remain operational and they are available to assist residents using alternate measures. Plexiglass barriers, enhanced cleaning and hand sanitizing stations will still remain in place at Town buildings.

Frequently washing or disinfecting your hands, getting vaccinated and staying home when you're sick will continue to be important to protect our community and limit the spread of COVID-19.
