Large Item Pick-Up

This year's pickup dates are June 7 and 9, 2022. Please register in advance with the Town office by calling (780)895-2010.

The Town will pick up your unwanted large items such as couches, shelves, tables, appliances and mattresses (Limit of 2 items per household). Fridges/freezers have a fee of \$10.00 each and mattresses/box springs have a fee of \$12.00 each which must be paid with registration.

Registrations are due by Friday, June 3, 2022.

Stand with Ukraine Fundraiser

Together with Lamont County and Fort Saskatchewan & District Chamber of Commerce, the Town of Lamont will be hosting a Pancake Breakfast Fundraiser on Saturday, June 4 to support Ukrainians displaced by the war. The breakfast will be at the Lamont Arena located at 4848 49 Street from 8:00 am to 11:00 am. Cash and humanitarian aid items will be accepted. 100% of proceeds will go to the cause, as all food items for the breakfast will be funded by our event sponsor - Cenovus Energy.

Yard Waste Pickup

Yard waste pickup started on May 4, 2022.

To have your yard waste collected please place your cart at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day. Your tote can be used for grass clippings, leaves, garden waste, small branches and small amounts of animal waste. Please ensure to remove your cart by the end of the day on Wednesday. The yard waste cart may NOT contain garbage, kitty litter or recyclable materials.

Yard Clean-up

With warmer weather approaching and snow disappearing all of the winter debris becomes visible. Please be thoughtful and cleanup any excess trash or unsightly material and all pet waste. Property owners, tenants and agents are responsible to immediately remedy any unsightly materials from yards, as per Bylaw 07/18 Community Standards.

RV Sani Dump Station

The dump station will open May 19 (weather permitting). It is located near the Curling Rink at the corner of 49 Street and 47 Avenue.

RV Parking

Camping season is upon us and recreational vehicles will soon be seen around the community. Pursuant to Traffic Bylaw 10/16 Section 3, RV's must be attached to a vehicle by which it may be drawn and can be parked on a roadway in Town for no more than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours. After the 24 hours the RV must be moved to an off-road location for forty-eight (48) hours before it may return.

Fire Season

Residents are reminded to be aware of the rules as well as the hazards associated with outdoor fire pits, portable fire pits and fire safety. For more information please refer to Section 8 of the *Community Standards Bylaw 07/18* on our website.

2022 Budget & Property Taxes

Tax Notices & Assessments will be mailed out on May 19, 2022. Taxes are due on June 30, 2022. A 12% penalty will be applied to any 2022 Taxes outstanding on July 1, 2022.

Council passed the Operating Budget resulting in a tax and requisition increase totaling 5.8 per cent. Residential homeowners can expect an average increase of \$11.91 per month based on an assessed value of \$174,762. Retaining core service delivery to residents and completing Capital Projects will be a key focus in 2022.

Economic Development Week

The Town of Lamont is excited to participate in Economic Development Week from May 9 to May 13. Economic Development Week is a North America-wide celebration and recognition of economic development professionals and the essential work they do every day. It is work that helps to create jobs, support businesses, and improve the quality of life in communities large and small.

2022 Capital Works Program

The Town of Lamont announced major infrastructure improvements through the 2022 Capital Budget including road reconstruction, concrete repair and utility improvements. The 2022 Capital Works Program construction will take place in 4 zones throughout the community, and is set to begin in mid-May with targeted completion set for the end of September.
