Reminder: Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP)

The Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) Bylaw 07/20 allows residents to sign up for a monthly, direct withdrawal of their property tax payments from their bank accounts.

This plan provides taxpayers the opportunity to pay their property taxes in monthly installments rather than the one large single payment that comes due once per year.

The plan runs from January 1 - December 31 yearly.

You may join the TIPP if:

- Your tax account is paid in full and you have no arrears or penalties from previous years;
- You have an account with chequing privileges at a financial institution;
- You do not currently pay your taxes through a mortgage company; and
- Your application is received by February 15th of the current year, provided that a pro-rated portion of your taxes are paid in advance.

Applications received after February 15, 2023 will not be eligible for the 2023 Tax Installment Payment Plan.

Yard and Fall Cleanup

Fall is fast approaching and it is time to make sure that your home and property are prepared for the fall season.

- Cut grass and clear weeds that could attract animals and pests.
- Trim trees and shrubs so that they don't overhang alleys and sidewalks.
- Rake/gather any fallen leaves, twigs and branches.
- Hot tubs and pools must be drained to the front street (**NOT the back lane**).
- Pet waste cleanup should be conducted frequently and ideally before the snow falls.
