Candidates Nomination Period:

- Candidates may submit their completed nomination papers starting January 1, 2025 until 12:00
 noon on September 22, 2025. The nomination papers must be accompanied by a deposit of
 \$100.00 payable by way of certified cheque, money order, cash or debit.
- Completed Nomination Papers must be delivered in-person to the Town Office 5307-50 Avenue, between the hours of Monday Friday 8:30 am 4:00pm except on Nomination Day September 22, nominations will only be excepted until 12:00(Noon).
- To submit your Nomination Papers in-person, please contact 780-895-2010 to schedule an appointment.

NOTE: IT IS THE CANDIDATE'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE SUBMISSIONS ARE RECEIVED BY THE TOWN WITHIN THE NOMINATION PERIOD. ALL SUBMISSIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE END OF THE NOMINATION PERIOD.

Election Day

Election Day will be held on Monday, October 20, 2025, from the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Lamont Recreation Hall.

Swearing-In Ceremony & Organizational/Regular Meeting

Following the 2025 municipal election, successful Candidates will be sworn-in as members of Town Council. The Swearing-In Ceremony is scheduled to take place in the Town Hall Council Chambers on Tuesday, October 28, followed by the Organizational meeting and regular Council meeting.

- Nomination Period: January 1 to September 22, 2025 (noon)
- · Nomination Day: September 22, 2025
- Municipal Election Day: October 20, 2025

Are you able to run as a candidate in the Municipal Election?

A candidate must be

- At least 18 years of age on September 22, 2025
- A Canadian Citizen
- A Resident of the Town of Lamont for 6 consecutive months immediately preceding nomination day
- Not otherwise disqualified or ineligible-see LAEA or MGA for clarification

	Include \$100.00 cash deposit by way of cash, Certitifed cheque, bank draft or debit.

	Review all forms before filing to be complete, if any are not completed your nomination will not be accepted until they are fully completed.
