UNSIGHTLY PROPERTIES:

REMINDER TO TOWN RESIDENTS THAT LAWN MAINTENANCE IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY, **INCLUDING THE STRIP OF GRASS BETWEEN BACK FENCES AND ALLEYWAYS. LAWNS** SHOULD BE MOWED ON A REGULAR BASIS.

ACCORDING TO BYLAW 05/24 - COMMUNITY STANDARDS, AN UNSIGHTLY INCLUDES, BUT IS **NOT LIMITED TO, UNCUT GRASSES OR WEEDS** THAT ARE LONGER THAN 10 CM.

2025 Budget & Property Taxes

Tax Notices & Assessments will be mailed out by May 15, 2025. Taxes are due on June 30, 2025. A 12% penalty will be applied to any 2025 Taxes outstanding on July 1, 2025. Please contact the Town Office at 780-895-2010 or general@lamont.ca to obtain a property tax receipt.

The Town of Lamont Council passed the Operating Budget resulting in a 0% percent mill rate increase. Residential homeowners can expect an average of \$12.41 per month increase based solely on the assessed value increase. The average assessment increased 6.4% in 2025 resulting in the average home value of \$214,425.

Retaining core services for residents will be a priority in 2025, with a key focus on the operational priorities identified in the 2025 operational budget and 2 capital projects including the 46 street improvements between 50 and 54 Avenue, that includes the utility and road replacement.

Town Wide Garage Sale

The annual Town Wide Garage Sale will be held on Saturday, June 7 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Registration will be open on May 1, 2025. Maps will be available on Friday, June 6 at the Town Office and at local businesses in Town.

Large Item Pick-Up

This years large item pick-up will be on Tuesday, June 10 and Thursday, June 12. Each household can register 2 large items such as couches, shelves, tables, large appliances, or mattresses. Residents can register by phone, 780-895-2010, or email, general@lamont.ca until Friday, June 6 at 3:30 p.m.

Items must be on the curb at the front of your house by 7:00 a.m. on the day of pick up.

There is a \$10 fee for each fridge/freezer and a \$12 fee for each mattress/box spring. All fees must be paid prior to pick up date.

Town Wide Clean Up

The annual Town Wide Clean Up will be held on May 10, 2025 a startup meeting will be held at the Picnic Pavilion in Hillside Park at 9:30 a.m. Clean up activities will run from 10:00 a.m. to noon with lunch provided for volunteers at 12:15.

If you cannot make it to the Town Wide Clean Up you can show your community pride by cleaning up the green spaces where you live during Pitch-In Week, May 5-9, 2025.

Yard Waste Pickup

Yard waste pickup started on May 2, 2025.

To have your yard waste collected please place your bin at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day (Friday). Your bin can be used for grass clippings, leaves, garden waste, small branches, and small amounts of animal waste. The yard waste cart may NOT contain garbage, kitty litter, or recyclable materials.

Yard Clean-Up

With warmer weather approaching and snow disappearing, all of the winter debris becomes visible. Please be thoughtful and cleanup any excess trash or unsightly material and all pet waste. Property owners, tenants and agents are responsible to immediately remedy any unsightly materials from yards, as per Bylaw 05/24 Community Standards.

RV Parking

Camping season is upon us and recreational vehicles will soon be seen around the community. Pursuant to the Traffic Bylaw 10/16 Section 3, RV's must be attached to a vehicle by which it may be drawn and can be parked on a roadway in Town for no more than twenty four (24) consecutive hours. After the 24 hours the RV must be moved to an off-road location for forty eight (48) hours before it may return. RV's must be parked on a paved or gravel pad and cannot be parked on lawns/grassy areas.
